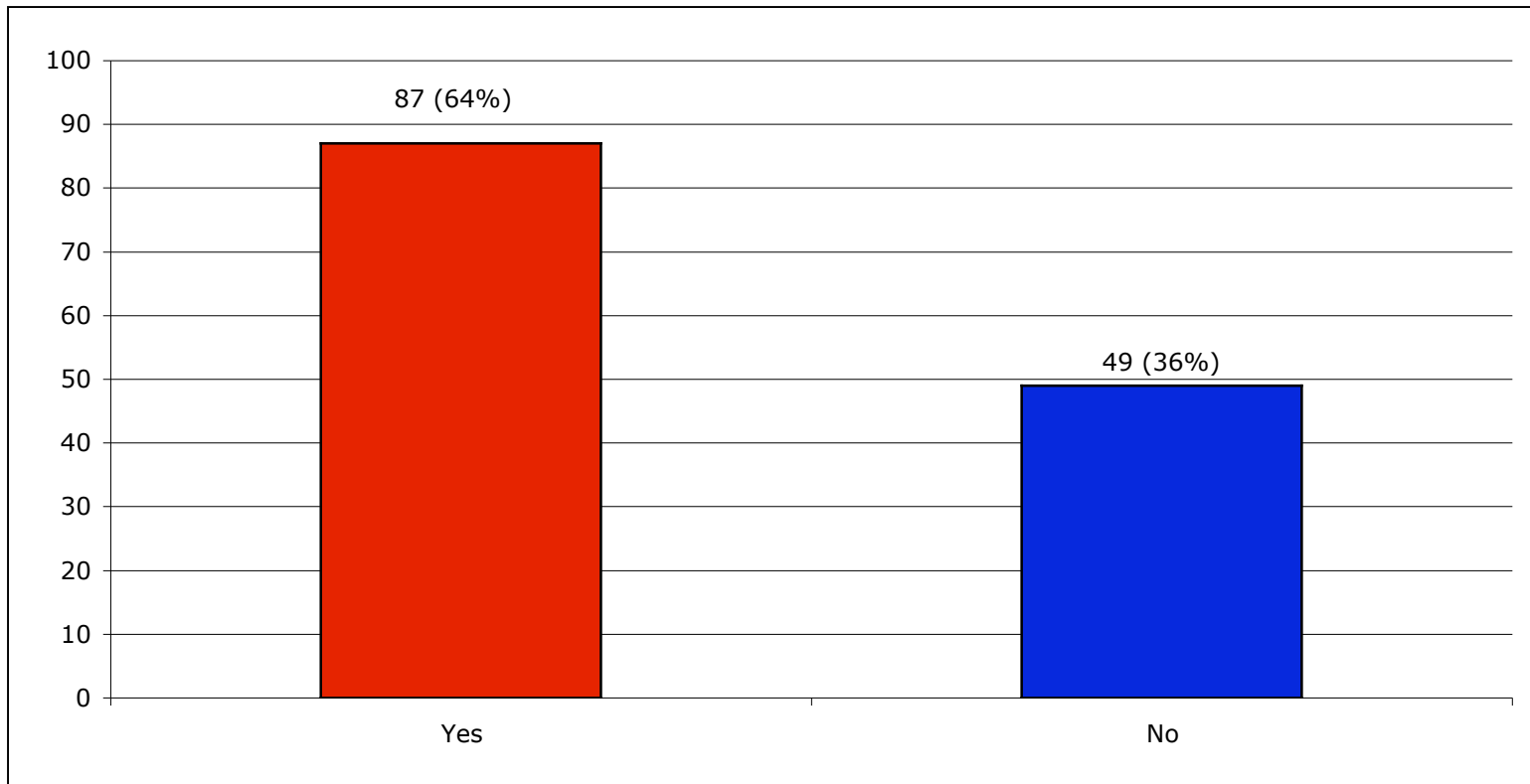
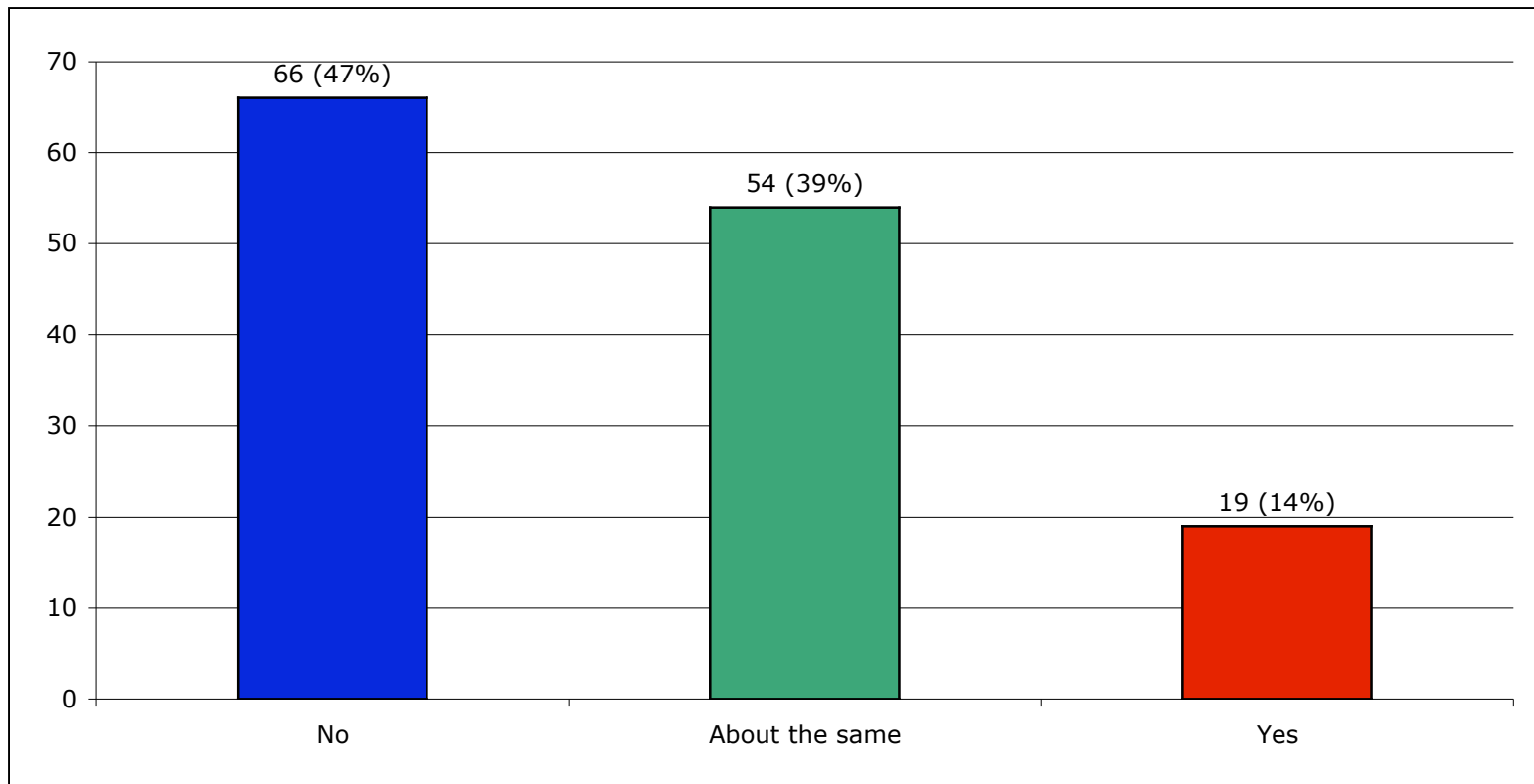


Question #1: Does your facility have an official heel pressure ulcer prevention program?



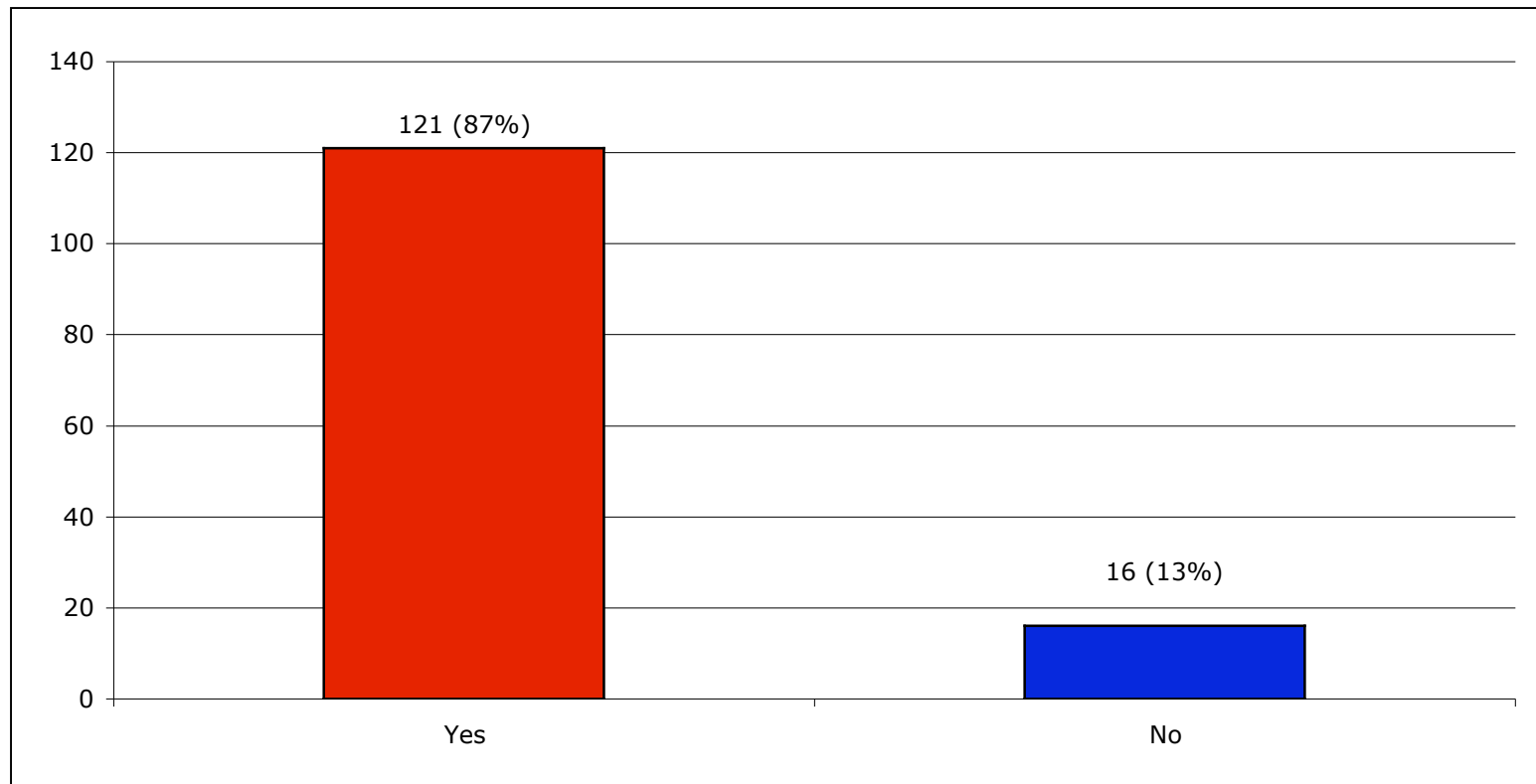
137 people or 89% of respondents answered this question.

Question #2: Has the incidence of heel pressure ulcers at your facility increased over the last year?



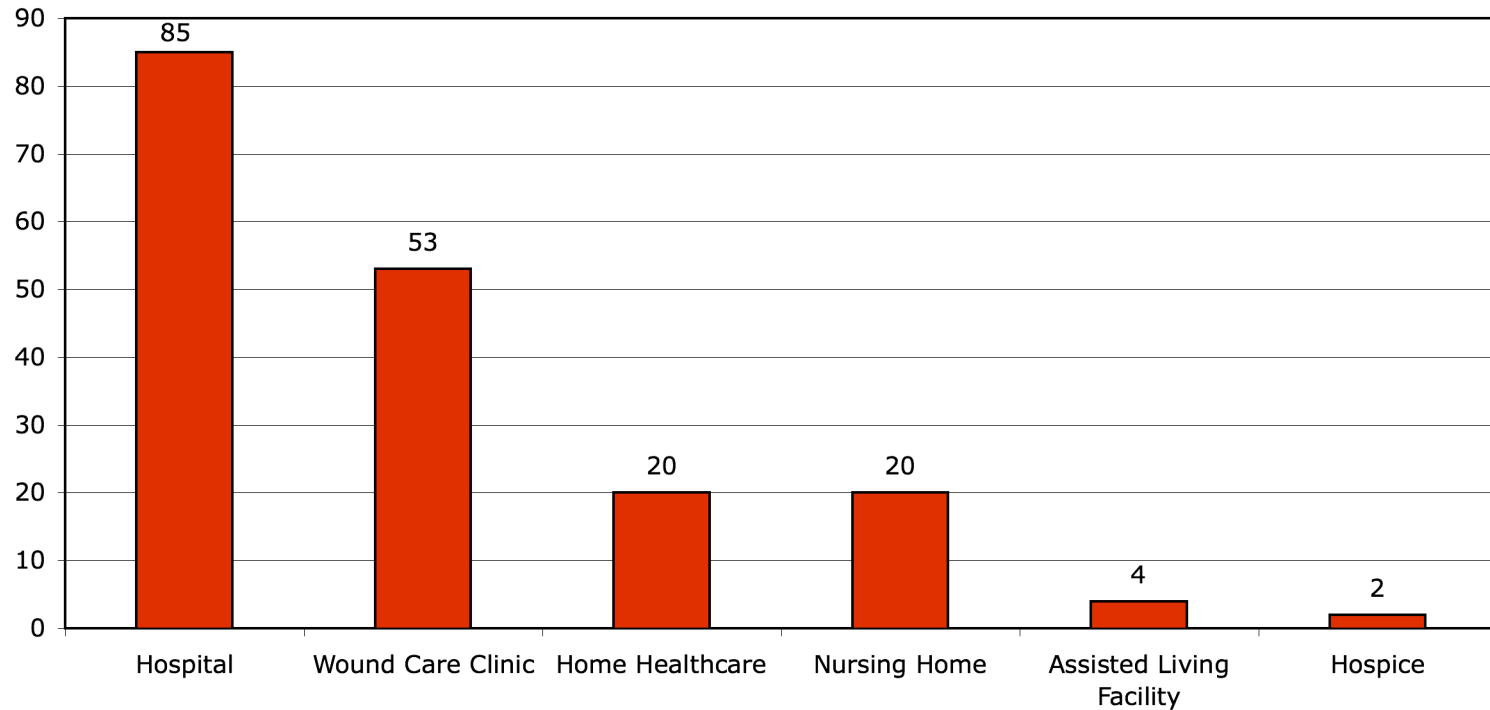
139 people or 90% of respondents answered this question.

137 people or 89% of respondents answered this question.

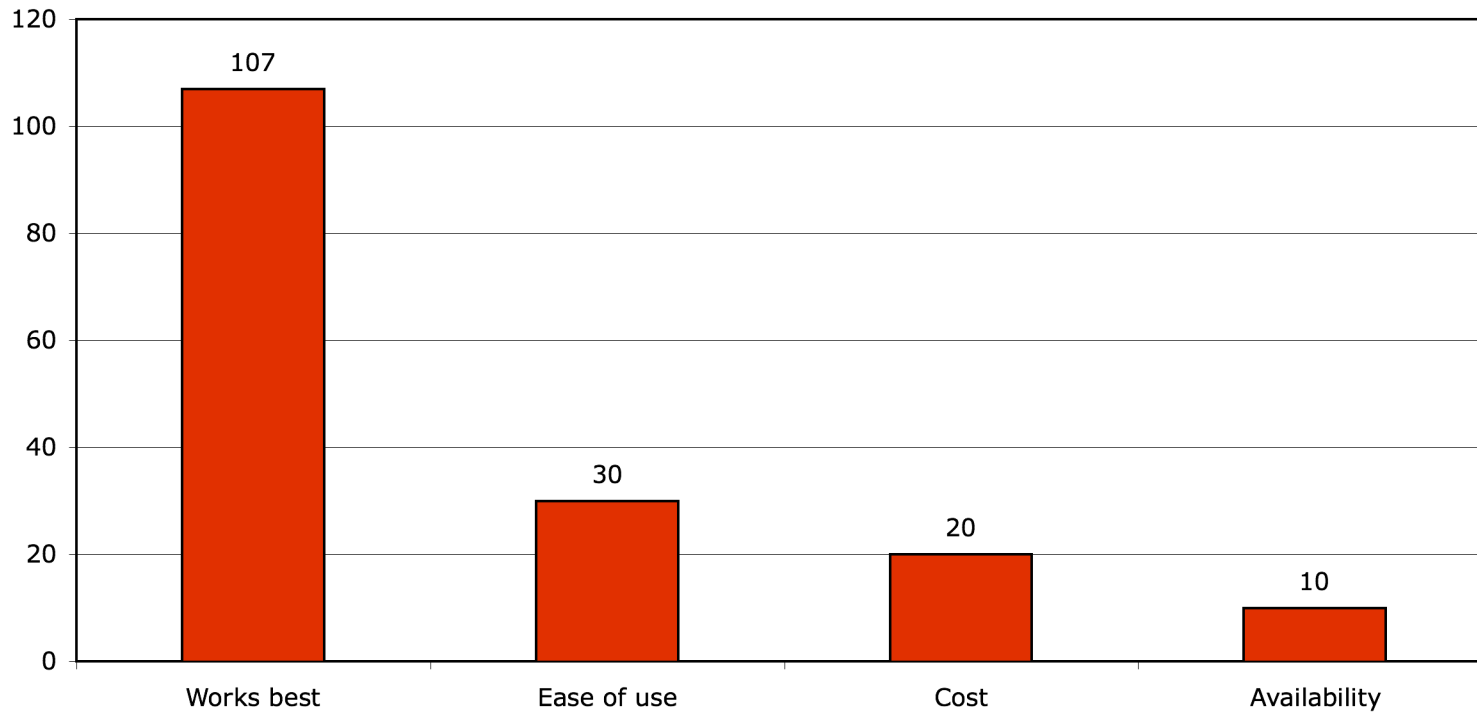
## Question #6: In what type of facility do you work?

18% of respondents indicated more than one type of facility.

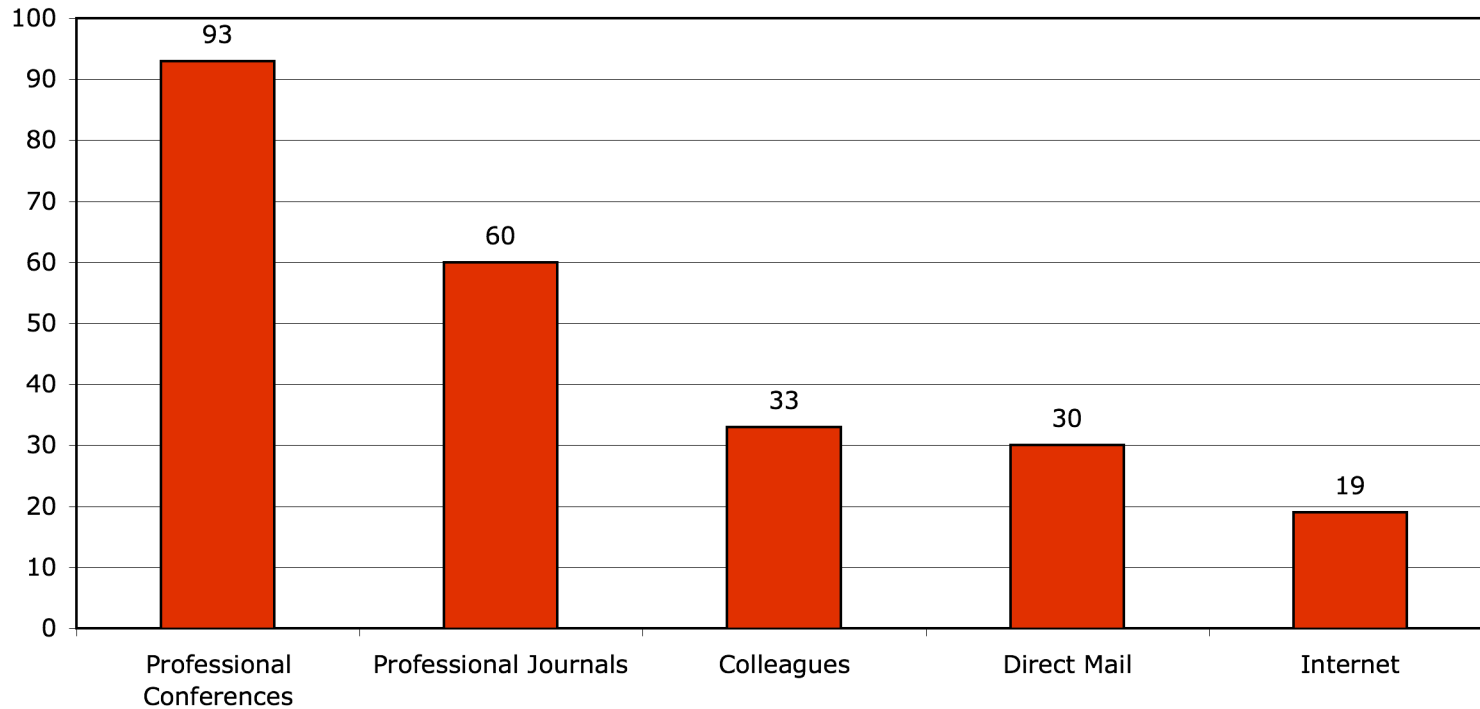
### Question #7: What is the single most influential factor in your recommendation of a pressure relief device?
